- 1. MAKE SURE EVERYONE IS ON THE SAILBOAT AND OKAY. ESTABLISH EYE CONTACT WITH EVERYONE.
- 2. ASK WHO IS IN CHARGE.
- 3. BE PATIENT!!!
- 4. MAKE SURE SOMEONE IS ON TOP AND BOTTOM BOARD.

IF BOAT IS SWAMPED OR TURTLED:

- 1. KEEP UPWIND FROM THE BOAT, BOW TOWARD THE BOAT.
- 2. THROW A LONG LINE TO THE BOAT AND HAVE THEM TIE TO BOW OF SAILBOAT. TIGHTEN AND CLEAT TO YOUR BOW.
- 3. REVERSE AND KEEP LINE TIGHT AND SLOWLY PULL BOW OF SAILBOAT INTO THE WIND.
- 4. HOLD BOAT IN PLACE WITH BOW OF SAILBOAT INTO THE WIND.
- 5. WAIT UNTIL THE BOAT IS RIGHTED. IMPORTANT TO KEEP LINE TIGHT AND BOW INTO WIND AS THE BOAT COME UP.
- 6. TO TOW BOAT DRY:
 - A. MAKE SURE SAILS ARE DOWN AND SECURE.
 - B. BAILERS AND TRANSOM HOLES ARE OPEN
 - c. CREW IS BALANCING BOAT ON BOTH SIDE WITH WEIGHT AFT TO KEEP BOW UP
 - D. TOW WITH TOW LINE MOVED TO TRANSOM AND TOW UPWIND FAST ENOUGH TO DRAIN, BUT SLOW ENOUGH TO BE STABLE.
 - E. AS BOAT DRAINS, YOU MAY INCREASE SPEED.
 - F. DON'T TURN TO GO DOWN WIND UNTIL LAST SIX INCHES OF WATER REMAIN IN BOAT.
 - G. TOW BOAT BACK TO CLUB OR AS INSTRUCTED.

IF BOAT IS NOT SWAMPED OR TURTLED:

- 1. GO TO TIP OF MAST AND PICK UP. AGAIN BOW TOWARD BOAT AND PROP AWAY
- 2. TRY TO POSITION SAILBOAT SO BOW IS IN WIND.
- 3. ESTABLISH EYE CONTACT WITH PERSON IN CHARGE AND ASK IF READY TO LIFT MAST.
- 4. TOSS MAST UP WHEN INSTRUCTED. NEEDS A STRONG TOSS TO GET PAST TIPPING POINT.
- 5. PICK UP ANY FLOATING GEAR.
